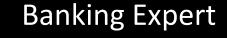

- The CMA ensures the protection of savings invested in Financial Instruments
- Organizes and develops capital markets in Lebanon, and promotes their use by investors and Issuers in Lebanon and abroad
- Reduction of systemic risks in capital markets.
- Protection of investors from illegal, irregular or unfair practices, including the prohibition of direct or indirect insider trading.



- Organizes the disclosure of information to persons who distribute Financial Instruments to the public
- Sets the work environment and organizes the professional activities of the persons who perform operations on Financial Instruments, while monitoring their compliance with professional ethics
- Regulates and controls the work of licensed Stock Exchanges, and the persons who provide deposit, clearing or settlement services



- Sets the general regulatory framework for listing Financial Instruments on stock markets
- Grants licenses to intermediaries who provide services to investors and Issuers
- Issues licenses to financial rating agencies, defines and regulates their functions and work process
- Licenses collective investment schemes, including mutual funds that invest in securitization operations

 Sanctions administrative violations of the Law and its implementation rules.

 Initiates legal action against insider trading crimes, and against the circulation of false or misleading information about securities or Financial Instruments, or their Issuers.

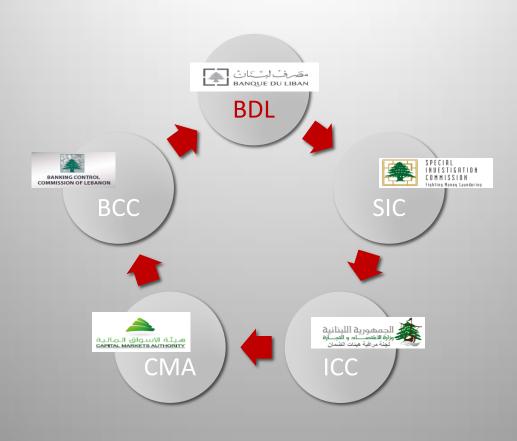




Lebanon's Regulatory and Financial Landscape



Lebanon Regulatory Landscape

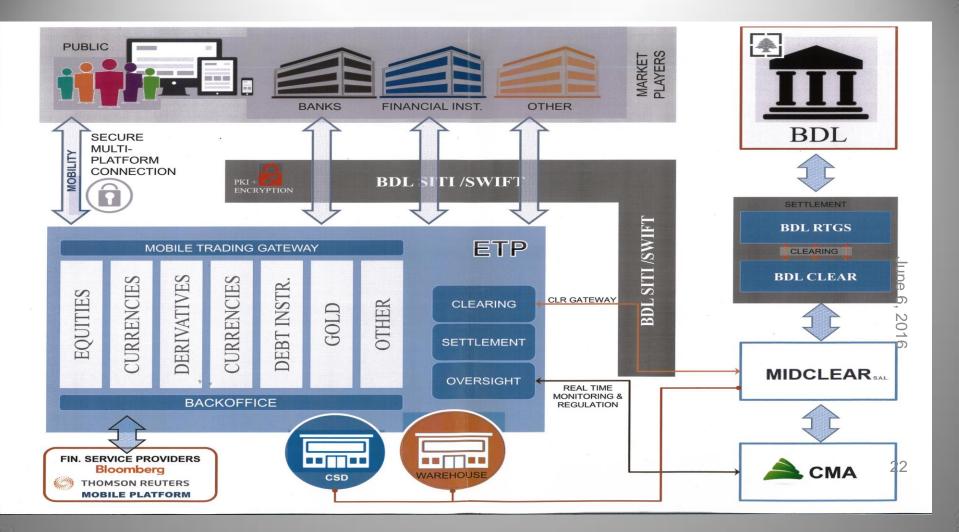
